

Remuneration package for primary teachers (PNET)

Sample* salary package for candidates with a B.Education or degree plus Post Graduate Diploma of Education with 5 years teachers experience

(* This example is indicative only, payments will vary depending on qualifications, the exchange rate, cost of living in Hong Kong and the time spent in Hong Kong as a contracted NET teacher. Contracts are for two years.)

<p>(a) Monthly Salary*</p> <p>Salaries quoted are approximations and are dependent on exchange rates, applicant's qualifications and verified years of teaching experience.</p> <p>Australian dollar amounts quoted are based on exchange rate of \$HK5.20 to \$A1.00 (February 09). Please note salary is subject to currency rate fluctuations.</p> <p>Salary is paid in HK dollars</p>	<p>The salary scale is from approx. HK\$18,840 to HK \$38,265 per month. Approximately \$A 43,400 to \$A 88,300 per annum. In addition to salary there is a \$A29,650 per annum special allowance (see below for more details)</p> <p>Candidates with a Degree and Post-graduate Diploma of Education (PGDE) or 4 year B.Education will enter at \$HK 24,050 per month. Those without a local recognised teacher training qualification or equivalent (category 4) will have a maximum salary of HK \$27,765 per month. Candidates with a teacher's certificate obtained after at least 2 years' full-time study or equivalent will have a maximum salary of HK \$30,445 per month.</p> <p>In addition to salary a special allowance (see (f) below) of approx \$A 29,650 per annum is paid to cover accommodation expenses.</p> <p>Salary is determined on the basis of qualifications and years of verified, relevant teaching experience.</p> <p>Salary is paid in Hong Kong dollars.</p> <p>The following examples of salary packages including the special allowance (assuming candidates have PGDE or 4 year B. Ed) are indicative only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 years experience \$HK 457,200, \$A 87,900 per annum approx. • 5 years experience \$HK 503,100, \$A 96,750 per annum approx. • 11 years plus experience \$HK 617,700, \$A118,780 per annum approx. <p>A 15% contact completion gratuity (bonus) is paid upon satisfactory completion of a NET contract (see (c) below). Hong Kong taxation rate is a maximum of 20%. A cash retention incentive is provided for NETs who renew their two year contract. For the third and fourth year of service, the retention incentive is 5% of base salary and for the fifth year onwards, the incentive is 10%.</p> <p>Please note if you have upgraded from a 3 year to a 4 year qualification during your teaching career your years of teaching experience are counted for salary assessment purposes may be calculated for whichever number of years is the greater – teaching with a 3 year qualification or teaching with a 4 year qualification. Teaching experience at pre-school level is not counted towards salary assessment.</p>
<p>(b) Increments</p>	<p>To be awarded on the basis of recognised qualifications and years of verified relevant teaching experience. Teachers performing satisfactorily will receive an increment after their first year of teaching in Hong Kong and each subsequent year unless NETs are on the top salary scale.</p>

(c) Contract gratuities	15% of the total basic salary over the two year contract period payable on completion the contract if your school is satisfied your performance and conduct during the period of service.												
(d) Passage*	Reimbursement of expenses on economy air tickets from and to the country of origin by the most direct route for the appointee, his/her spouse and accompanying children, up to 5 persons including the teacher, for each contract.												
(e) Baggage allowance* based on	Reimbursement of travelling baggage expenses from and to the country of origin will be provided <u>on first appointment only</u> . (f) Special allowance*	A fixed monthly allowance of approximately HK\$12,950 # (Approx \$A29,650 per annum) (A NET will not be eligible for the special allowance if he/she or his/her spouse is already receiving the same or housing allowance from his/her own employer.)												
(g) Medical allowance*	As reimbursement for the appointees to take out medical insurance, up to HK\$1,400 per year for single appointee and \$HK5,400 per year for married appointee accompanied by spouse and/or children.												
(h) Salary advance	Payable <u>on first appointment and on application</u> an amount not exceeding 2 months' salary, and repayable monthly within the first six months following the month in which the payment is made.												
(i) Leave entitlement	Terminal leave : School summer vacation at the end of each contract Casual leave:) Sick leave:)Same as for local teachers Maternity leave:)
